Michamwi Pingwe Peninsula

Easily accessible from all over the island, The Rock is in the south east, on the Michamwi Pingwe peninsula.

A 20-minute car drive from Paje, 90 mins from Stone Town and 90 minutes from the extreme north tip of the island, Nungwi.

Zanzibar has many transport options. Whichever you choose, do make sure it is a licensed, insured operator. Reputable operators display prominently their credentials and accreditation.

Always feel free to ask for operating permits and insurance proof. After all, you wouldn't do any different in any other city, but here the regulation is not as strong or perhaps well controlled.
